- The bus departs from the park and ride off exit 45 of the Maine Turnpike on Friday, May 3th at 6:00 AM and returns on Monday, May 6th around 4:30 PM. Picks up and drops off at the Wells bus terminal at exit 19 also, about 6:30 AM, pick-up and drop off at I-495 rest stop mile 87 Chelmsford MA about 8 to 8:15 A.M. usually stop at Charlton rest area on I-90 for bathroom break and snacks. Next pick-up and drop off location is Nosahogan Odd Fellow Lodge 3200 E. Main St. Waterbury CT about 10:00 A.M.
